- From Switzerland (south or north provenance: North/Est Italy, Germany): Highway A2, Exit Bellinzona SUD, Follow Locarno, Ascona, Brissago, then continue to Italy and Cannobio (about 15 min. from Ascona).

Alternative path from Italy/France: Highway A26 to Gravellona, Exit Gravellona/Verbania, follow to Verbania and then Cannobio (about 30 min. from Verbania).
